Terms & Conditions

The accompanying form should be completed and returned by post or in person by **16th November 2024** to Christmas Open, St Ives Society of Artists, Norway Square, St Ives, TR26 1NA. Please print clearly and in block capitals.

Applicants may submit up to three works. The work to be considered for inclusion in the Exhibition will be chosen by a panel of curators. No correspondence will be entered into concerning their decision.

Your piece/pieces should be delivered to the Members' Gallery between 10.00am and 4.00pm on Saturday 16th November. When the work is delivered the bottom part of the entry form will be given back to you as a receipt. This must be produced at the time of collection of work.

Whilst the utmost care will be taken in handling and storing the work, the Society cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage. Artists are responsible for insuring their own work if they wish to.

There will be an submission fee of **£10 for each work**. This fee will cover handling and administration, and the remainder will contribute to the Building Regeneration Fund and is therefore not refundable. Please ensure payment is made via card, cash or transfer by Saturday 16th November at the latest.

Exhibited work will go on sale at the price stated on the entry form. A commission of 40% is charged on all sales. This commission must be accounted for by artists when calculating the selling price.

IMPORTANT: Work must be presented ready for hanging with a taut string or wire attached and labelled with the artist's name and painting title on the back. If your work is framed, it must be in a sale-able condition.

The selection of paintings will take place after the 16th and you will be notified of whether your work had been chosen by the end of the day on 20th November.

The exhibition continues daily until 31st December and all work must be collected on Thursday 2nd January between 11.00am and 4.00pm from the Mariners Gallery. If you cannot collect your work in person, please give the receipt form to someone who can collect it for you.



The Gallery will be closed after the show closes and storage space is very limited, so please contact the gallery if you are unable to collect on the allocated day to make alternative arrangements for collection as soon as is possible. Work that remains uncollected after 12 weeks will be disposed of in a manner decided upon by the Society.

Notification will be sent to all artists as soon as possible after the selection and hanging. If you could include your email address it will speed up the notification process. Work not selected can be collected by arrangement (01736 795582).

Please note that work cannot be accepted by courier delivery unless collection can be made in person.
